

DISTRICT OF NEW HAZELTON

BYLAW NO.62

A Bylaw to adopt a system of House Numbering for the District of New Hazelton.

WHEREAS Section 579(h) of the "Municipal Act" provides for House Numbering;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the District of New Hazelton in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. A system of house numbering is hereby adopted for the District of New Hazelton. The said system shall be implemented and administered in compliance with Schedule "A" as attached to and forming part of Bylaw No. 62.
2. Numbers assigned to buildings and structures shall be so placed as to be easily read from the roadway upon which such building or structure is deemed to front in compliance with the aforementioned Schedule "A" of Bylaw No.62.
3. Numbers assigned to buildings and structures may, except as provided in Section 2 hereof, be placed on any part of a building or structure, but no number shall be placed at a lesser height than three feet, or a greater height than ten feet from the immediate grounds upon which the building or structure is constructed.
4. The series of digits in each number assigned to a building or structure shall be of uniform size and no digit shall be less than 4 inches in height.
5. The Council may, at its discretion, order that any numbers attached or otherwise applied to any building or structure be removed or replaced if such numbers do not conform with the requirements of this bylaw, or such numbers are incorrect and cause confusion, or such numbers are unsightly.
6. If within six months from the date of registration of this bylaw, the assigned numbers have not been placed on the buildings or structures in conformance with this bylaw, then the municipality either by its employees or others may provide for having the work done at the owners expense and the charges for so doing shall, if unpaid on the 31st day of December in any year, be added to and form part of the taxes payable in respect of that real property as taxes in arrears.
7. This bylaw may be cited as "District of New Hazelton House Numbering Bylaw No.62, 1983".
